- Dare I say that this further division and disarray is exactly what we're told would happen in Bible prophecy in this the last days.
- I'll take it a step further and suggest what we're seeing is a textbook case of "divide and conquer" in the realm of the demonic.

- This brings us full circle to the aforementioned uncharted territory that I believe is the likes of which we've never seen before.
- I would argue that we are now entering into a time in human history that will bring us to the end of human history, as we know it.
- Namely, the last seven years of human history the Bible calls the time of Jacob's trouble, also known as the 7-Year Tribulation.

Matthew 24:21 - For then there will be great tribulation, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be.

- The question every one of us should be asking ourselves is this; "if we are seeing it begin to happen now, how close are we?"
- In other words, if we're starting to see what will ultimately be fulfilled during the Tribulation, how close are we to the Tribulation.
- Actually, Jesus answers this question for us when he was answering questions from the disciples about the signs of His return.

Luke 21:28 - When these things begin to take place, stand up and lift up your heads, because your redemption is drawing near."

- This is why we do these weekly prophecy updates and end with the Gospel of Jesus Christ and the simple ABC's of Salvation.
- The Gospel, or good news is that Jesus was crucified, buried, rose again on the third day, and is coming back for us one day.

### **The ABC's of Salvation**

- The A is for Admit you're a sinner and your need for the Savior, (Romans 3:10, 23 – 6:23).
- The B is for Believe in your heart that Jesus is Lord and God raised Him from the dead, (Romans 10:9-10).
- The C is for Call upon the name of the Lord and confess with your mouth that Jesus Christ is Lord, (Romans 10:9-10, 13).
