

Bible Prophecy Update – February 9th, 2020

- For today's update I sense that the Lord would have us to take a step back and catch our breath, given all that's just happened.
- I think you would agree that the first month of 2020 has been a busy one in terms of all the significant prophetic developments.
- If this were any indication of what's ahead, then we would do well to buckle up our spiritual seat belts, and roll up our sleeves.

Here's a list of just 10 things that happened in January in no particular order:

1. The Australian wildfires that started last July have now burned more than 16 million acres
2. Qassem Soleimani was killed by a US strike while in Baghdad after Iran attacked our embassy
3. China finally confirmed that they identified a new virus named Coronavirus, which is now spreading globally
4. Britain finally left the EU in what's been dubbed Brexit, which started in March of 2017 when the UK formally announced it
5. The Russian government of Dmitry Medvedev's Second Cabinet resigned making Vladimir Putin a supreme ruler
6. President Trump unveiled his long awaited Peace Plan known as "The Deal of the Century"
7. Benjamin Netanyahu and Benny Gantz accept the White House invitation for the unveiling ahead of their March 2nd election
8. The impeachment trial of President Trump commenced in the Senate leading to an acquittal just this last week
9. There were escalations in current wars, natural disasters, and there were growing protests worldwide as well
10. The Bulletin of the Atomic Scientists moved the Doomsday Clock to the closest to midnight (100 sec.) since starting in 1947

- Back in November of 2016, when Trump was elected President I sensed that the fulfillment of Bible prophecy was speeding up.
- Here we are almost 3 ½ years later and I have to confess the swiftness with which everything is happening is quite surprising.
- I suppose we shouldn't be surprised, given this is exactly what we were told would happen at the time of the end in the Bible.

Revelation 22:12 - And, behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be.

2 Peter 3:9 - The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. Instead he is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.

2 Peter 3:11b-12a – 11b ...what kind of people ought you to be? You ought to live holy and godly lives 12 as you look forward to the day of God and speed its coming.

- The question becomes how is it possible to speed His coming, and the answer is to reach and win the lost before it's too late.
- This is why we do these weekly prophecy updates and end with the Gospel of Jesus Christ and the simple ABC's of Salvation.
- The Gospel, or good news is that Jesus was crucified, buried, rose again on the third day, and is coming back for us one day.

The ABC's of Salvation

- The A is for Admit you're a sinner and your need for the Savior, (Romans 3:10, 23 – 6:23).
- The B is for Believe in your heart that Jesus is Lord and God raised Him from the dead, (Romans 10:9-10).
- The C is for Call upon the name of the Lord and confess with your mouth that Jesus Christ is Lord, (Romans 10:9-10, 13).
